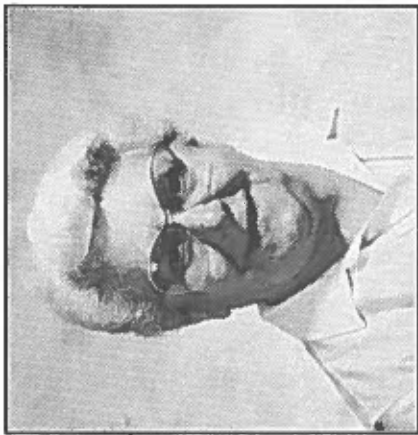

A BIT OF BACKGROUND INFORMATION

The order of the Little Sisters of Hoboken was founded in the seventh century by Saint Wilfrid, a bishop of England. He established the first convent and school known as the Wilfrid Academy. Many years later a small group of pioneering sisters set out for America to establish a motherhouse in Cleveland. But they got off the plane in Newark by mistake. The order was "founded" by the Newark Airport Police and the new motherhouse was established in Hoboken, New Jersey. It was at that time that the order of St. Wilfrid elected to change the name to the Little Sisters of Hoboken and they have been affectionately known as the "Little Hobos" ever since. It was from this convent that Sister Mary Regina, Sister Hubert and Sister Robert Anne, set sail for the Mediterranean to establish their leper colony. Today, the order has both nuns and brothers as members — all doing various good works in the Diocese of Newark. They also operate Mount Saint Helen's School of Hoboken.
