



## **2022 Kodiak Arts Council Artist Award Guidelines**

The Kodiak Arts Council (KAC) offers local artist awards each year to support and encourage individual growth in the arts. Artist awards may be used for a variety of artistic pursuits, including but not limited to: attending workshops or seminars, purchasing equipment or materials to begin, advance, or complete work, and/or supporting an artist's time to develop new work.

A designated Ginny Shank Dance scholarship is also awarded annually in the discipline of dance.

The Awards Committee will review the applications and select awardees. Decisions will be based on completeness of application, quality of artistic work within the context of the applicant's experience and career stage, impact of the award on the applicant's artistic growth, and intended benefit for the Kodiak community.

The Awards Committee will make six (6) awards in the amount of \$250 each to six (6) artists. One (1) Ginny Shank Dance Scholarship award will be made in the amount of \$500.

Funds should be used for artistic endeavors taking place between May 2022 and May 2023.

Artists of all ages working in all artistic disciplines are encouraged to apply. Eligible disciplines include, but are not limited to: dance, theatre, visual arts, music, storytelling, cultural practices, digital art, fiber arts.

Awards are not intended for college tuition, college room & board, or travel to & from college. Awards are also not intended to supplement school group events or travel.

Applicants must be a resident of the Kodiak Island Borough. Individuals from all Kodiak Island communities are encouraged to apply.
