THE STORY OF JOSEPH

Jacob, a man highly favored and blessed by God, has 12 sons. His two youngest, Joseph and Benjamin, are especially favored as they are the children of his old age and both have been mothered by Rachel, his favorite wife. Like most dotting fathers, Jacob has trouble hiding his favoritism; he richly rewards Joseph with a multi-colored coat. Joseph's eleven brothers are extremely jealous and decide to do away with him. They sell Joseph to some Ishmaelites, cover his precious coat with goat's blood and then report to their father that Joseph is dead.

Joseph is taken to Egypt, sold into slavery and given to Potiphar, an officer of Pharaoh. Joseph quickly rises to the top of the household. Potiphar's wife, noting Joseph's good looks and appealing nature, tries to seduce him. When he refuses her advances, she deceives Potiphar into thinking Joseph has taken advantage of her. Joseph is sent to prison, where he meets the Pharaoh's butler and baker. Joseph's new friends have troubling dreams. Joseph, being filled with the spirit of prophecy, interprets the dreams. Sometime later, Pharaoh also has a recurring dream that he cannot understand. It is about seven fat cows, seven thin cows, seven ripe ears of corn and seven tattered ears of corn. Having heard of Joseph's skill, the Pharaoh sends for him.

Joseph interprets Pharaoh's dreams and is made ruler of all the land, second only to Pharaoh. The brothers in Canaan, meanwhile, are starving. Jacob sends them to Egypt to gain favor with Pharaoh and receive grain. Joseph meets them and they do not recognize him. Joseph then plants a valuable cup in Benjamin's sack and accuses the brothers of robbery and deceit. The brothers beg for forgiveness and plead for Benjamin's life, still not recognizing Joseph. Joseph, sensing their humility and repentance, reveals his true identity, and the twelve brothers are overcome with love and gratitude. They send for their father, Jacob. Jacob comes to Egypt and is overjoyed at the sight of his son. The entire family is reunited and they praise the Lord.
