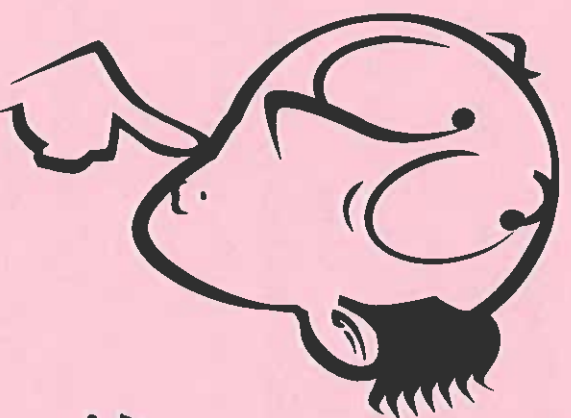
Next Show
