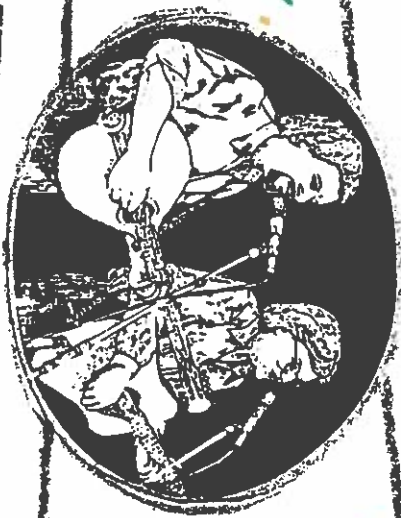

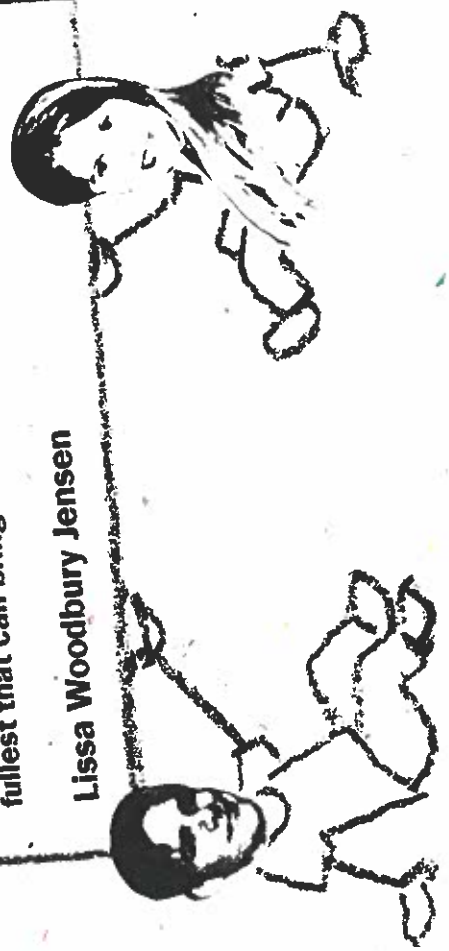
From The Director

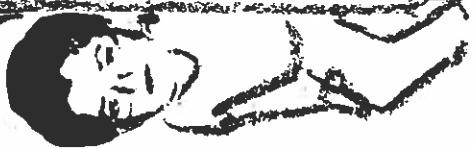
