Since 1986, touring actor/director Rod Molahn has been bringing Will Shakespeare to life in performances and productions throughout the United States and Canada.

In addition, Molahn's extensive experience as teacher and director are the foundation for a variety of workshops and residency offerings.

Molahn has been selected for the Artist in the Schools Residency

Programs for the Arts Commissions of both Washington and Oregon. The CD recordings of his performance *A VISIT WITH WILL* and *THE SONNETS* have received Awards of Excellence and Distinction for writing, creative concept and characterization by The Communicator Awards of Arlington, Texas.

This is Rod's third visit to Kodiak and he hopes not the last.

LEAH LOPEZ

Leah Lopez is a seventeen-year-old senior in high school. She began acting four years ago and has made performance part of her life. Since then she has participated in three dance concerts, choreographing one piece in each show. She has played a role in six Arts Council and three Drama Club productions such as *JOSEPH AND THE AMAZING TECHNICOLOR DREAMCOAT*, *WAIT UNTIL DARK*, and *STEEL MAGNOLIAS*.
